

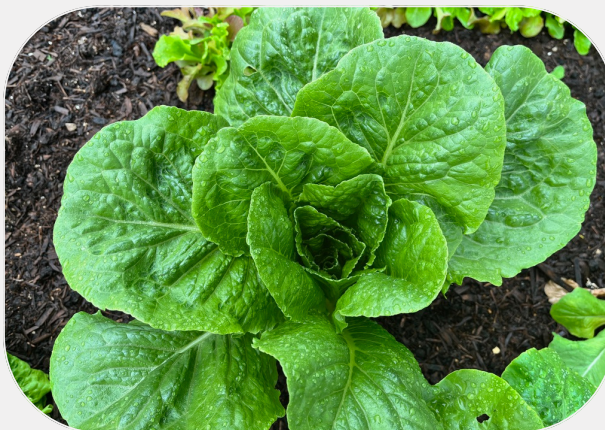


BEING FORMED IN OUR FAITH
